Lachit Borphukan was a general of the Assam Kingdom, born on 24th Nov, 1622. This year i.e. on 24th Nov, 2022 entire State of Assam will be celebrating his 400th Birth Anniversary, thereby glorifying his bravery and contribution towards his country.

Lachit Borphukan is famously associated with the Battle of Saraighat, 1671 where the Mughals, the rivals were forced to retreat from Guwahati. Battle of Saraighat is an outstanding example of good leadership and one of the unforgettable battle in the Indian history. In order to remember his heroic act and to celebrate the victory of Assam Army Lachit Divas is celebrated every year on 24th Nov.

Declut Berplukan died in 1672, where
his remains are kept at the Declut
Maidan constructed in the same year
by King Udayaditya Singha at Hoobhngapara
6 km from Jodhpur.
